What Application Packs are

The implementation side of the Pack model.

- 01 Application Packs implement business capabilities for specific target applications.
- 02 They bind business meaning to APIs, services, workflows, adapters and identities.
- 03 They are separate from Business Packs because not every customer runs every application.
- 04 They let the core platform remain stable while application coverage grows.

Application families

Separate collateral by target application.

SAP

Procurement, finance, sales and logistics capabilities.

Oracle EBS

Purchasing, payables, order management and HR capabilities.

Salesforce

Customer, opportunity, order and service capabilities.

ServiceNow

ITSM, workflow and service operations capabilities.

Dynamics

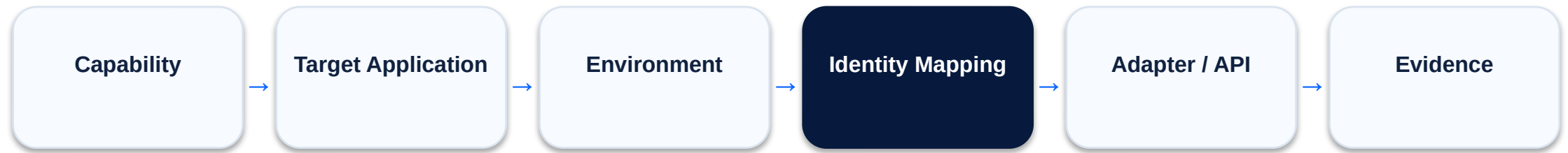
Business applications and customer operations.

QuickBooks

Small-business accounting and finance scenarios.

Capability remains stable; implementation varies.

Publish a general Application Packs overview once.

Then publish separate business and technical decks by application family.

Use capability matrices to show planned and available coverage.

04

Avoid unsupported certification or compatibility claims until proven.
