

# Governed Execution & Security

Identity, policy, environment boundaries, execution evidence and auditability for autonomous business.

## Autonomy with control

Business autonomy should increase access to business outcomes without increasing uncontrolled access to underlying systems. Autonomy makes governance part of the execution path rather than an afterthought.

## Control points

- Identity: establish who or what is acting
- Authority: determine whether the actor can request the capability
- Policy: evaluate business rules and limits
- Environment: resolve the correct application and environment
- Evidence: preserve decisions, execution and verification

## Agent boundary

Agents should request bounded business capabilities instead of receiving broad application credentials. This separates reasoning from privileged execution and creates a consistent control surface for built-in and external agents.
